- Fear based

APPROACH

- Work out a more formal schedule
- Break the process down in small pieces
- Keep their list manageable
- Work on building their confidence
- Submit rolling applications and CSU applications EARLY so they can feel successful early on.
- Work on LIKELY applications first
- Copy the parent on every email.

TRANSCRIPT & COURSE SELECTION

- Be sure they are on track to make up anything lower than a C-
- CSU will not accept lower than a C-in A-G req.
- Packing their schedule with easy classes isn't always better.
- Steer them towards their strengths in core areas.
- Have a minimum of four academic solids in their senior schedule.
- Summer school

TESTING

- Test late – they need to finish corresponding curriculum
- The B/C needs to consider both tests
- Need a structured class or tutoring
- Take practice exams
- SAT in May
- SAT Subject Tests in June
- ACT in June
