# BBC and ABC

Minimum admission requirements:

GPA, SAT/ACT, subject requirements

Impacted campuses:

Fullerton, Long Beach, Pomona, San Diego,

San Luis Obispo, Sonoma

Priority filing period:

October 1 to November 30



# DBC

11/20/08 - CSU declared systemwide impaction  
Thereafter Enrollment measures taken by  
individual campuses

Under systemwide impaction:

“requirements” for campuses;

“allowances” for campuses

# Under Impaction: Requirements

- 1) Admit all local CSU-eligible (“local” area defined by the campus)
- 2) Close to first time freshman applicants no later than March 1, 2009
- 3) Work within a reduced number of special exception slots

## Under Impaction: “Allowances”

- 1) Restrict certain admission categories
- 2) Stop taking applications after Nov 30<sup>th</sup> without much advance notice
- 3) Use supplemental admission criteria to control enrollments
- 4) Not accept applications in August 09 for Spring 2010

# San Francisco State University

- 1) Closed to lower division applicants and second baccalaureate applicants
- 2) Stopped accepting first time freshman applications on December 10<sup>th</sup>
- 3) Moved initial deadline of March 2<sup>nd</sup> for transfer applications to February 2<sup>nd</sup>
- 4) Set document deadline to complete files
- 5) Adhering to deadlines (our “gatekeepers”)

# San Jose State University

1. Used Nov. 20<sup>th</sup> as critical date
2. Put on wait list: all FTF applicants Nov. 20<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> (not in Santa Clara County)
3. Closed to all applicants Nov. 30<sup>th</sup>
4. Offered CSUEB and CC option to those on wait list

# Advice To Current High School Juniors

- 1) Apply to local CSU campus-meet minimum eligibility requirements
- 2) Apply to out-of-area CSU campuses, may need to exceed minimum eligibility requirements
- 3) Monitor messages from campuses; beat campus deadlines (“early bird”).
- 4) Prepare PLAN B, PLAN C, D, E, etc.
