- Poor time management and organizations skills
- Not signing up with our program until in crisis mode

3 ATTRIBUTES FOR SUCCESS

- Self advocacy skills and knowing your resources
- Perseverance-having a clear goal in mind
- Self discipline and knowing your strengths and weaknesses and using them

CASE STUDY

- 29 YEAR OLD, CAUCASIAN, FEMALE
- TRANSFER FROM PRIVATE COLLEGE (JUNIOR)
- DOCUMENTED ADHD AND READING DISORDER
- MAJOR:COGNITIVE PSYCHOLOGY

PRESENTING ISSUES

- FAILED IN PRIVATE SCHOOL SETTING: FEELINGS OF INADEQUACY
- FEELING “STUPID” DUE TO DISABILITY
- TIME MANAGEMENT AND ORGANIZATION ISSUES: NOT TURNING IN HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS ON TIME
- ANXIETY ISSUES

ACCOMMODATIONS/SKILLS DEVELOPED

- EXTENDED TIME ON TEST TO HELP REDUCE ANXIETY, AND REFERRED TO PSYCHOLOGICAL CENTER FOR ANXIETY WORKSHOP
- DEVELOPED TIME MANAGEMENT AND ORGANIZATION SKILLS THAT WORKED FOR STUDENT
- HTC: STRUCTURED ENVIRONMENT TO STUDY/E-TEXT
- WORKED ON IDENTIFYING STRENGTHS AND METHODS TO HELP HER BE SUCCESSFUL
