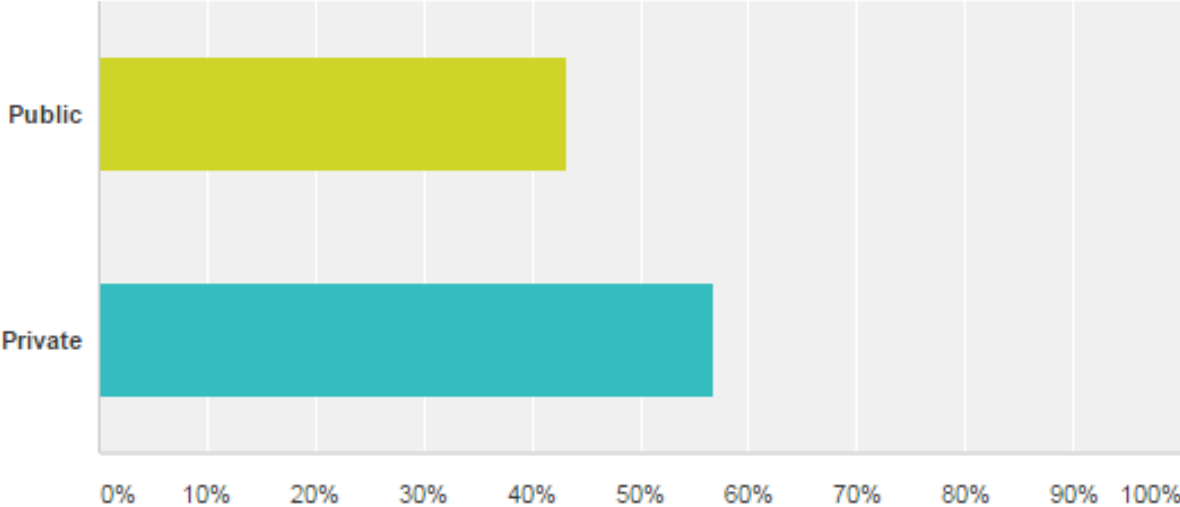

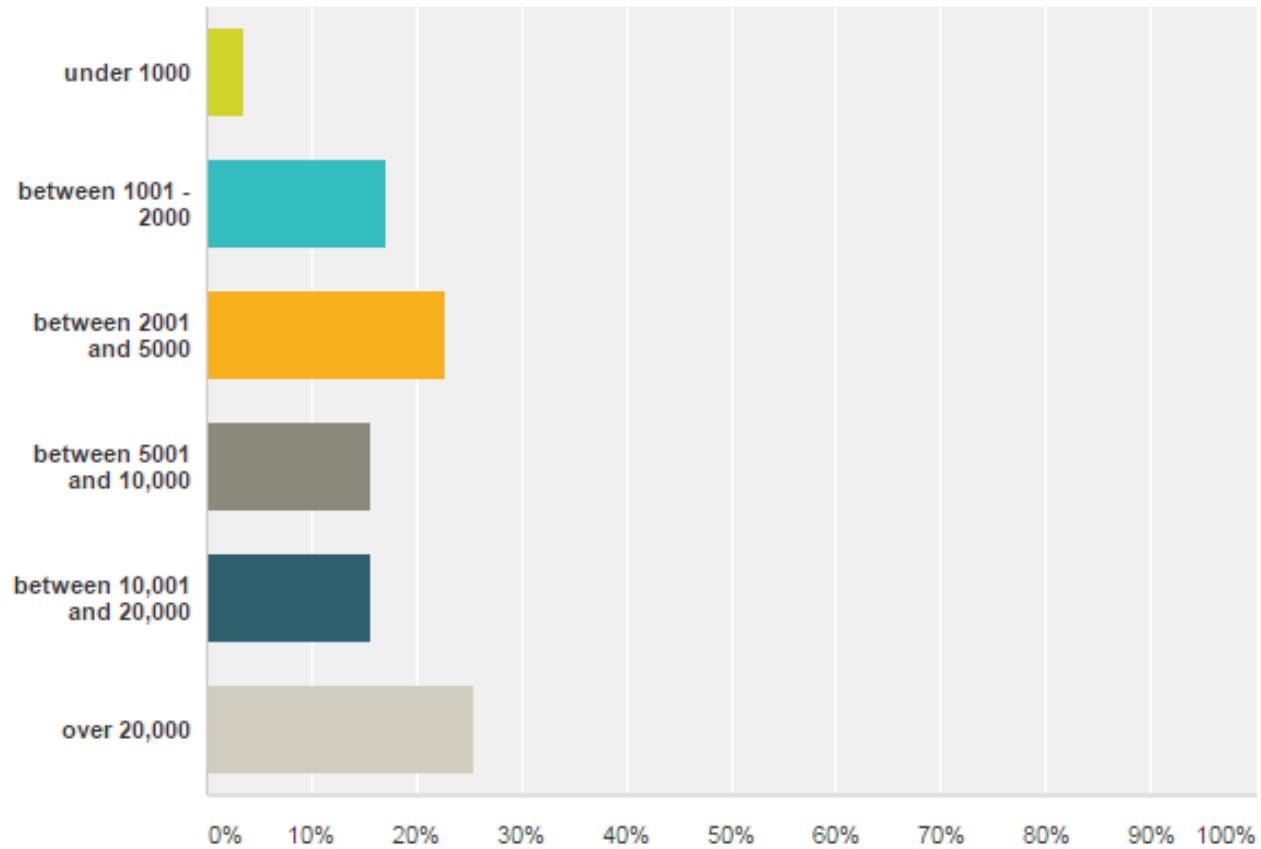

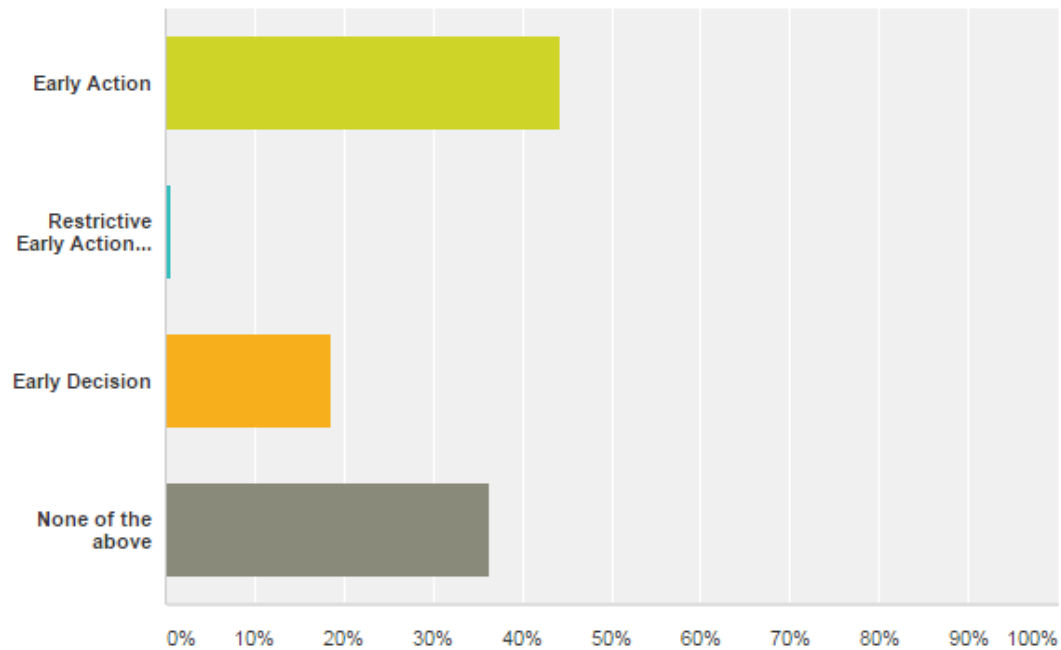
Undergraduate Enrollment

Undergraduate Admission Plans

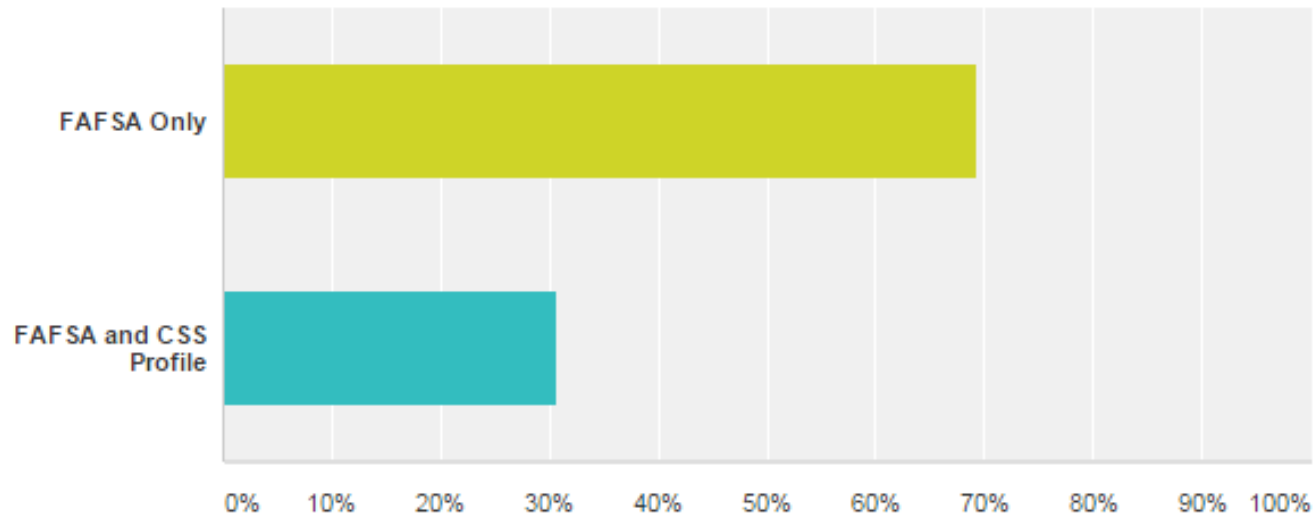

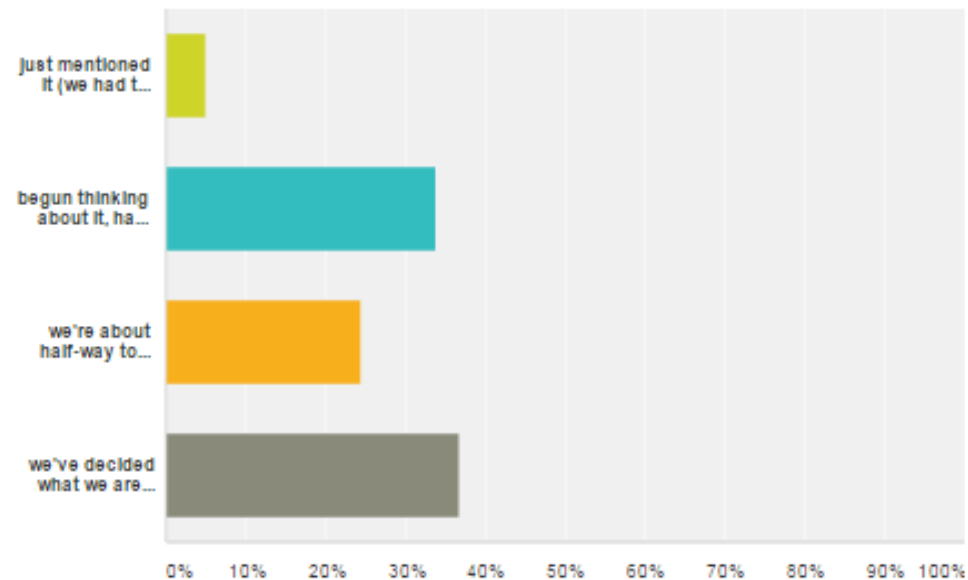

How much planning have the admissions and financial aid staffs done so far to implement PPY?

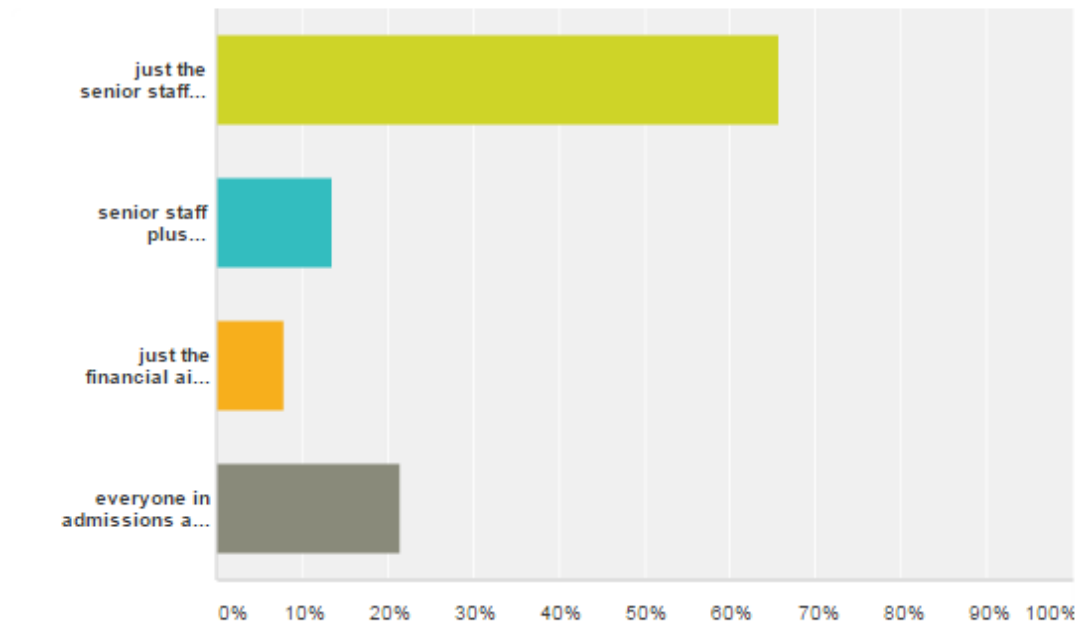

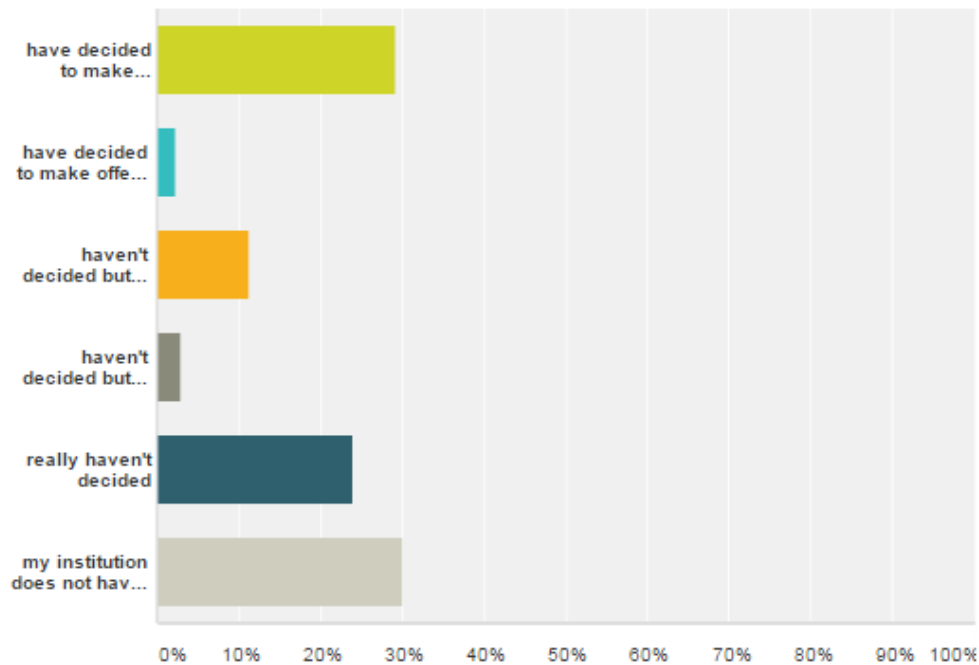

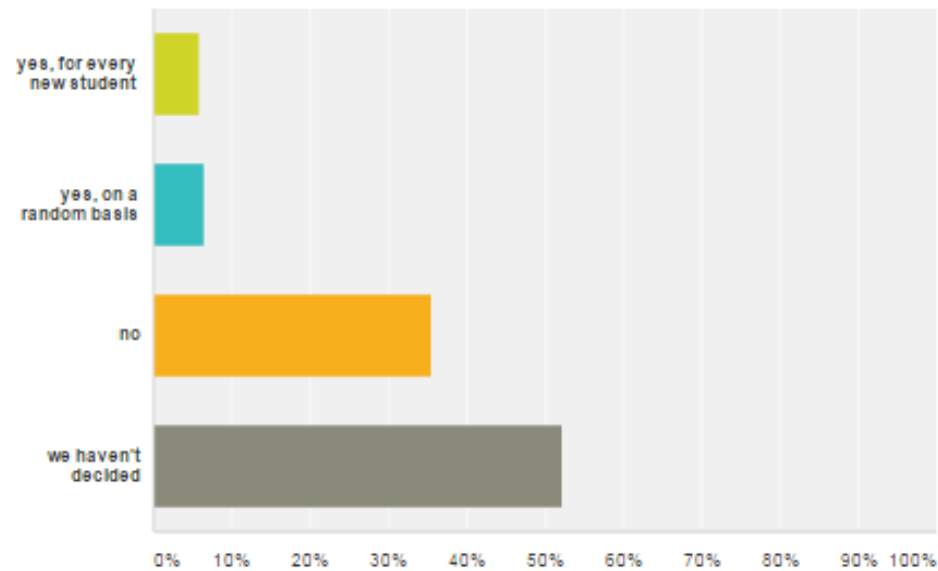

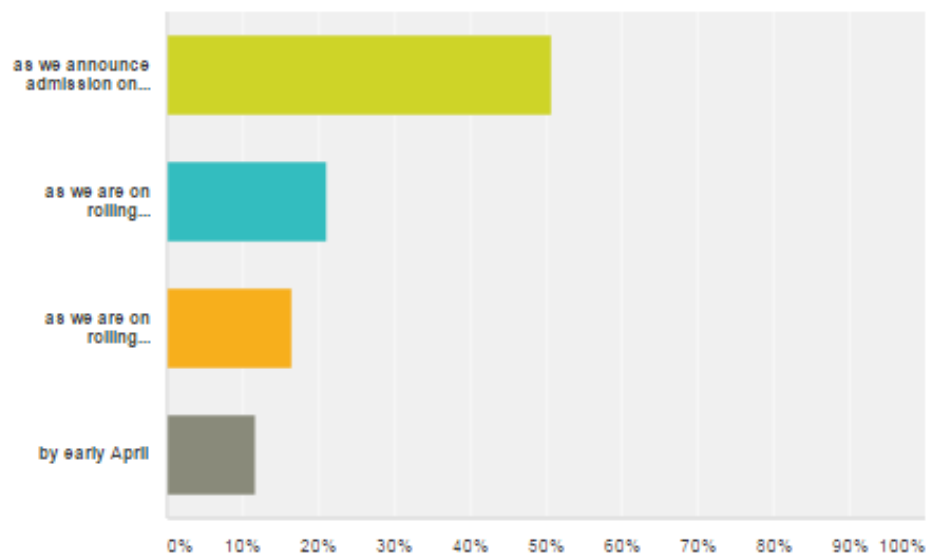

For your students admitted in the regular cycle (not EA/ED etc.) when will you begin posting/mailing their financial aid awards?

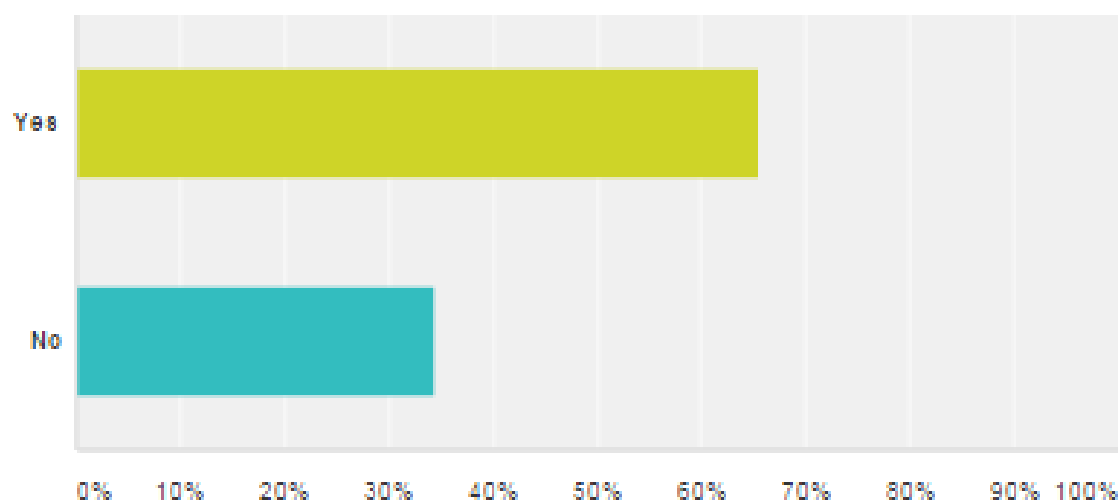

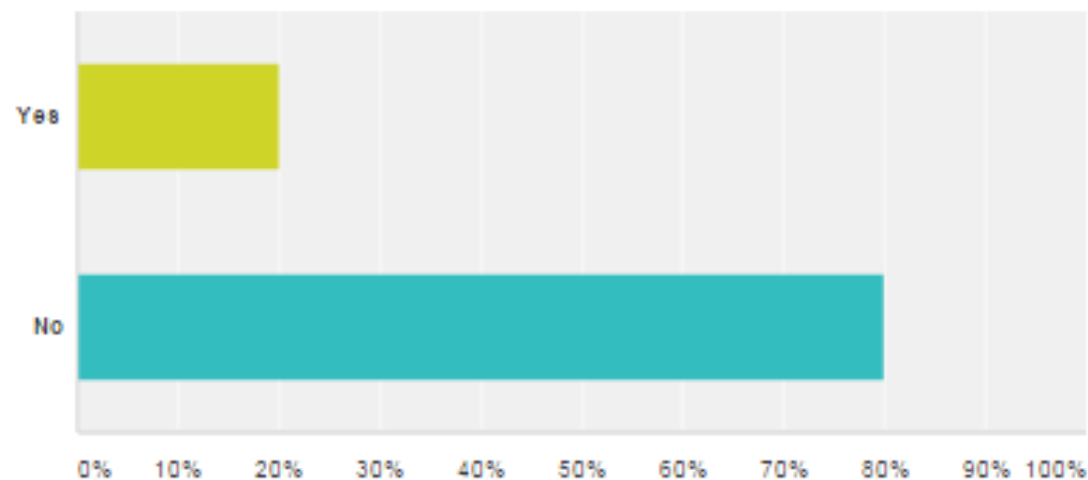
