

Letter From NACAC – January 10, 1967

Noted in the letter from Ted S. Cooper,
Executive Director of NACAC

- A revised constitution that was adopted on October 8, 1966
- States “needing a home” in the regional affiliate: CA, HI, AK, AZ and NV
- National Conference to be held in San Francisco in 1971

Dear Emery:

Enclosed is a copy of the revised Constitution adopted on October 8, 1966, and the most recent membership roster. At your recommendation, I am sending a set of these materials to Marilyn Blum. Between you, I hope you will be able to organize a California ACAC or a regional association in time to elect representatives to the Assembly, which will meet for the first time next October. According to the Transition Document, delegates should be elected in April or May, 1967. As I read the Constitution, California would be ineligible to select Assembly delegates if it does not have an organized ACAC. No-one has spelled out the specific procedures for organizing a state or regional group, but the usual organizing procedure is to write a Constitution for the group and to file copy of this document with the national association. I have enclosed a copy of the recently written New England ACAC Constitution as a sample. Other state or regional groups have written considerably different Constitutions, and I think the national ACAC will need to interpret quite liberally the requirement that state groups show their purposes "are consistent with the purposes of the Association of College Admissions Counselors".

The Membership Directory lists all of the California school and college members with the exception of Thomas Downey High School in Modesto, California. If California decides (and I hope you will) to organize a regional association, rather than a state association, the states still needing a home are Alaska, Arizona, Hawaii and Nevada. It seems unrealistic to add Alaska to your family and we can probably talk the Pacific Northwest group into adding Alaska to their membership if any Alaska school ever applies for membership. Perhaps some of your people, who make an annual trip to Hawaii to recruit, will find a reason to do some recruiting in Alaska, and you can sell some Alaska school or college on joining ACAC.

If you haven't heard, you might like to know that we have scheduled the 1971 Annual Conference for San Francisco. This could be a selling point in recruiting new ACAC members from California and the adjoining states.

Call or write if I can be of help as you and Marilyn organize the California or Far West ACAC.

Dear Fellow WACAC Members:

We had several excellent suggestions on our constitution, and we've written them into a new version, which is enclosed. Please let us know if you find anything that you'd like to change. If we don't hear, we'll present it as is for final adoption in the fall.

Before we counted ballots, Bill Wheaton gave us a Sherman-like statement about his candidacy, and we also were required by the Constitution to see that every State in our region is represented on the Board of Directors. After we'd made adjustments for these exceptions, our count came out in the following order (all duly checked by Price Waterhouse, and here is the envelope):


1. Emery Walker 3
2. Marilyn Blum 3
3. Willis Stork 2
4. Byrns Fagerburg 2
5. Charley Orme 1
6. Jim Taylor 1

This is a little embarrassing to us, we admit. On this basis Emery is President and will serve as a Director and Delegate to the National Assembly for three years; Marilyn is Vice President, will become President in a year, and will serve as a Director and Delegate to the National Assembly for three years; Willis is Secretary-Treasurer and will serve as a Director for two years; Byrns will serve as a Director for two years; Charley and Jim will serve as Directors for one year.

The WACAC will have its first meeting in Minneapolis in October - at the time of the ACAC Annual Meeting. We can meet again in January at the time of the College Board Western Regional Meeting. Agenda items are welcome.

We are grateful to you for your confidence. Here's to a bigger and better WACAC!


