#### NACAC ASSEMBLY on Sat. Morning

#### 19 delegates represent NACAC/WACAC members

- NACAC Assembly elections of next NACAC President-Elect and 3 NACAC Board Members
- Vote on continuing suspension of CEPP enforcement until the DOJ investigation is resolved
- Vote on deleting the 3 targeted anti-trust sections of the CEPP
- Results of the Assembly votes will be announced at the Saturday Afternoon NACAC membership meeting

## NACAC Membership Meeting on Sat. Afternoon

- Vote on a bylaw change accepting the proposed changes to the membership model
- Vote on a bylaw change expanding the authority of the NACAC Board in special, limited circumstances

As you consider your vote, remember that the vast majority of the NACAC Board has been indirectly elected by you.

If the NACAC Board is not given the authority to quickly resolve the DOJ investigation through a consent decree, 1) NACAC does not have the financial reserves required to sustain the legal fees required if the DOJ investigation continues and 2) WACAC is likely to be added to the investigation – quickly depleting our financial reserves as well.
