How to Make the Most of Your College Visit

Pre-Arrival

Schedule an "official visit" online several weeks in advance. Call / email if necessary.

Be aware of holiday / summer schedules.

Take advantage of official offerings and don't just go on a tour with your cousin!

Info Session
Interview
Class Observation
See facilities not on the tour
Grab the student newspaper
Check out bulletin boards
Hang in the student center
Talk to people on campus!

Financial Aid Office You may need to request components that aren't available on the online scheduler



On Campus

Take the lead! Introduce yourself to staff.
Shake hands. Show confidence.



Hard to get into desired classes?

Focal points of the social scene?

Professors easily accessible or only during office hours?

How much time do students spend off campus? On campus?

Current hot button issues on campus?

Any major forthcoming changes to programs? Facilities? Administration?

Easier for certain majors to study abroad?

International student programming continuous or just first year?

Follow-Up

Take time to reflect, and take notes so you remember your thoughts.

What surprised you?
What did you love?
What made you hesitate?
What are your follow up questions?
What do you need to research further?
Who might be a good contact?
What information might strengthen your supplemental essays about the college?
